

We registered 87 new patients!



EDAHC team completed 45 715 health checks for our mob aged 0-25 and 29 for our mob aged 26-90



Our EDAHC and Yadhaba team conducted 9 Mental Health Treatment Plans for our mob aged 0-25



Our teams conducted 1,297 episodes of care for our Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander patients

INTEGRATED TEAM CARE -CHRONIC DISEASE SUPPORT

Yerin Aboriginal Health Service provides nursing and transport support to help Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people to manage their chronic health issues.

The ITC program offers:

- Nursing support tips to manage your condition, help explain treatment options and set your own goals
- Transport assistance to and from health appointments
- Provides financial support for health appointments and access to medical aids
- Supports you in maintaining your independence

Do you have a Chronic Disease? Do you live on the Central Coast? Do you identify as Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander? If so you may be eligible to become an Integrated Team Care (ITC) client.

If you are interested in accessing this program, please speak to your GP or Practice Nurse about a referral to the ITC program. An active or current care plan document is all you need to access the program.
