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Hi, I am Demetrios, originally born here on Darkinjung land, although I grew up on Yuggera and Eora lands, with Greek ancestry. I am here on a Jawun secondment at Yerin Eleanor Duncan Aboriginal Health Centre (EDAHC).

Jawun started in 2001 with the objective of building partnerships between Corporate, Government and Aboriginal community organisations via sharing skills and knowledge to create real change. I currently work at Westpac's Commercial Banking arm, assisting Relationship Managers with credit proposals for medium to large organisations that are growing in an ever-changing economic environment.

I have been at Yerin Eleanor Duncan, for four weeks of my five-week secondment. In that time. I have learnt a lot and feel like I have contributed to a very welcoming team. Yerin Eleanor Duncan is a prime example of a growing organisation that supports the Aboriginal community on the Central Coast, that has rapidly grown in the last 5 years. They have responded to the needs of community through GP services and wellbeing programs such as Integrated Team Care, Yadhaba Wellbeing, Dhanggan Gudjagang, NDIS and Dental programs. In addition, they recently took on a Permanency Support Program to support Aboriginal children.

The skills and knowledge transfers I have gained during

my secondment have been plentiful, from learning about Aboriginal culture, increasing my knowledge about the healthcare sector, learning about government funding contracts and learning about risk management in health care.

My key takeaway was understanding how growing organisations are driven by key people that run them. Without these key people, it would be difficult to grow an organisation in a world of limited resources.

So far on my secondment, I have assisted with the development of a risk management exercise to ensure Yerin Eleanor Duncan and their programs continue to deliver quality service to the community. With two weeks left, I'm looking forward to continuing my discussions with managers and team leaders to embed this.

Overall, this has been a great experience in my personal and professional development and I would suggest any corporate, government or Aboriginal community organisation continue to support this initiative.
