

We operate within a fully renovated, purpose-built dental practice, located within our old Medical Centre at 37 Alison Road, Wyong and a new Outreach Dental Clinic also operates in Woy Woy Public Hospital.

Our services include all general dentistry, extractions, some root canal therapy on Anterior teeth, some wisdom teeth extractions, restorations, fillings, mouthguards, dentures (based on a waiting list) and dental services for those under 18 years of age.

To become a member of Yerin, you must be:


- Accepted by the local Aboriginal Darkinjung community as being Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander
- At least 18 years of age
- Living in the Central Coast local government area
- Supported by two current Yerin members
- Approved by Yerin's Board

When making your application to become a Yerin member, you will be asked to provide proof that you meet these criteria.
